Sub: State level review of social security programmes held on 20.8.2016.

Madam/Sir,

A performance review meeting of all District Social Security Officers was held on 20.8.2016 at Bhubaneswar and progress of schemes for the welfare of PwDs, senior citizens, transgenders and drug addicts and pensioners was discussed.

2. It was decided that every district will send proposal for pre-matric and post-matric scholarship at the rate of 7 and 3 per block respectively. The defaulting districts will send the bank account details under UDID scheme with the authentication of the Bank Branch Manager. New proposals from different NGOs for various welfare programmes of the Department will also be recommended by the different districts. More number of cases will be referred under marriage incentive scheme as there is a target of 400 for this year. Adequate number of Self-Help Groups for PwDs under Livelihood Mission of Panchayati Raj Department will be set up. District Level Senior Citizen Committee should be constituted and their meeting should be held by the District Collector at the earliest. Health camps should be organised for senior citizens in every district headquarters. Transgenders should be identified and registered and sensitization workshops should also be held on issues relating to transgenders. Steps should be taken for proper identification of drug addicts as per the direction of the Hon'ble High Court in WP(C) No.20631 of 2014. Digitization of NSAP beneficiaries should be completed in all districts and Aadhar seeding should also be improved. Pending utilisation certificates for NSAP should be submitted immediately so that Government of India can be moved for release of the second instalment by middle of September, 2016.

2. Under the National Trust Act, the meeting of the Local Level Committee should be held under the chairmanship of District Collector every month to review the welfare activities of persons suffering from autism, cerebral palsy, mental retardation and multiple disabilities, and requirement of funds should be posed before the Department. A few Districts have not even spent 5% of the funds released to them such as Kandhmal. The District Collector should ensure that no administrative bottlenecks exist in the use of funds already released. A few Districts have not submitted UC under SIPDA Scheme such as Ganjam, In the absence of submission of the UC funds have been held up by the Government of India for retrofitting of buildings under the accessible India campaign in Bhubaneswar. Collectors must ensure submission of the SIPDA UCs. The requirements of posts of non-teaching staff of the Special Schools have not come from a few Districts. The Collectors need to ensure that no Special Schools suffer because of lack of staff-teaching or non-teaching-and all requirements are posed before the Department.

3. DSSO, Nuapada will take steps to coordinate with Director, SVNIRTAR, Cuttack for operationalisation of the outreach centre at Nuapada approved by Govt. of India by providing them suitable building space. The DSSOs should maintain proper communication with the relevant officers of the Department to sort out all issues relating to implementation of various programmes as well as establishment and budgetary matters.

4. District-wise achievements against different deliverables are enclosed.
