Sub: Universal coverage of pension under MBPY

Madam/Sir,

In view of the additional requirement of pensions as per the feedback received from various Districts, Government have been pleased to make additional allocation under MBPY of 3.48 lakh beneficiaries. District-wise details are given below.

2. You are requested to immediately identify additional beneficiaries as per your requirement and start disbursement of pensions w.e.f. 15.05.2018.

3. Government have also been pleased to decide to allow disability pension to all disabled persons even below 5 years of age and fulfilling other eligibility norms of MBPY. Accordingly, steps may be taken to identify new beneficiaries for disability pensions under MBPY.

4. While disbursing pension care must be taken to disburse ₹500/- to all beneficiaries of old age pension who have crossed 80 years of age and all disabled persons having 60% and above disability.

5. You are reminded that during this month all beneficiaries have to be provided ₹100/- towards summer allowance as communicated to you vide letter No.3642 dated 07.05.2018
